WA SPORTS STAR AWARD

Eligibility:

Nominees must be eligible to represent WA and:

- Be a product of the WA sport system residing in WA.
- Be a product of the WA sport system residing interstate or overseas and eligible to represent Australia.
- Have relocated to the WA sport system and are resident in WA. The nominee must have been a resident for two years to be eligible.
- Shall not currently compete against WA or a WA-based team in a National League competition or event.

The following criteria will be considered for judging:

- Level of competition/s participated in
- Outstanding achievement/s during the nomination period (at State, National and / or International level)
- Significance of achievements and contribution to their sport

Special Notes:

- Interpretation: 'Product of the WA sport system' – Contribution or participation in the WA sports system for a minimum of seven years (three years for juniors).

QUESTIONS FOR CONSIDERATION

- Indicate the highest level of competition possible for your sport during the period 1 December 2022 to 30 November 2023
- Indicate the nominee's highest level of performance during the selection period
- Indicate the nominee's highest status of competition during the selection period.
- Detail the nominee's most outstanding achievement on which the nomination is based
- Please give Nominee's current ranking (if applicable)
- Please give Australia's world ranking (if applicable)
- Please rank (in order from the highest) the possible international events for your nominee to have competed in the nomination period. e.g. Olympic Games, World Cup, Grand Prix etc.
